Young artists aged 3 - 15 years are invited to submit entries for exhibition and judging. All submissions will receive a certificate of participation and the artworks judged best in each age group will be awarded a prize.

THEME

An Environmentally Friendly City

What does an environmentally friendly city look like to you?

The world's population is rapidly increasing and by 2050, 68% of people are expected to live in cities. Blacktown City holds the largest population in NSW with 395,000 residents and is expected to grow to 569,000 by 2036. When the population increases our need for resources such as housing, transport services, energy and water also increases, and this means we will have a larger impact on the environment.

If we continue to use technologies that burn fossil fuel we will accelerate climate change, causing increase of extreme weather events such as droughts, flooding and extremely hot days.

We know that young people have amazing ideas, so we are asking you to think of creative ways to live differently in cities and decrease our environmental impact as the population continues to grow.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entrants are encouraged to address the environmental theme in their work, however this is not compulsory.
- There are no fees for entry. Works submitted will not be for sale.
- Blacktown Arts on behalf of Blacktown City Council reserves the right to limit the display to a maximum of 200 works according to space availability.
- Entrants must be aged 3 – 15 years old on Thursday 18 November 2021.
- Entrants must live or attend school within the Blacktown Local Government Area. We also accept artworks from entrants who have attended workshops at The Leo Kelly Blacktown Arts Centre.
- Blacktown Arts, Blacktown City Council and/or the media (with Council's permission) will use images of entrants' artwork to promote the exhibition and program in signage, websites, social media and catalogues
- The decisions of the Judges and Blacktown Arts on behalf of Council in all conditions of entry, display and judging will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Artworks that are not collected will be held for 1 week after the arranged pick-up date but will thereafter be disposed of without further notice.
- If COVID restrictions and public health guidelines prevent an exhibition or impact the specified dates, Blacktown Arts staff will advise entrants via email and/or the public through our social media platforms

ENTRIES

- Each young artist is limited to 1 entry
- Maximum size of works accepted:
Two-dimensional works – A3 size (30cm x 42cm), not including frame
Three-dimensional works – 30cm x 30cm x 30cm
- For two-dimensional works, entrants are strongly encouraged to frame submitted work. This will allow professional presentation in the exhibition. Blacktown Arts staff reserve the right to attach hanging devices where necessary.
- Each entry must be the original work of the entrant and must have been completed since November 2020.
